### THE TEMPTATIONS OF JESUS

The temptations of Jesus give us a double insight: insight into the mind of Jesus and insight into our own minds.

1. The temptation to turn stone into bread: To use his power selfishly for his own purpose or to bribe/persuade people to follow him for what they could get out of it. This is precisely what Jesus always refused to do. This may be a very common and strong temptation in our life as well. God has given each one of us a gift. We can ask: 'What can I make for myself or what can I do for others with this gift?'
2. The temptation to offer sensation to lead people to God: Jesus knew that a gospel founded on sensation has no perennial value, but only newspaper value.
3. The temptation to compromise: To change the world by becoming like the world; in other words, replacing God's values with the values of the world.
