### THE TRANSFIGURATION OF JESUS

The Transfiguration of Jesus gives us a glimpse into the heavenly world. Two things happened: A double revelation.

1. God as Trinity: The Father in the voice; The Son in the man; The Holy Spirit in the shining cloud.
2. Jesus' divine glory, the glory that was to be achieved by embracing the cross. Jesus woke the disciples up from their trance, touching and asking them to go down to toil on earth, to be scorned and crucified. Touched by God St Paul said: 'When God is with us, who can be against us?' Touched by God, St Augustine exclaimed: 'Our hearts are made for you, O God, and they shall not rest until they rest in you.' Touched by God, St Francis of Assisi sang: 'Make me a channel of your peace.' We too need this touch of God. It is then that we too get a glimpse into heaven – in the moments of prayer, adoration, Eucharist etc. Yes, God can touch any heart that opens its door to His love.
