**Mass Intentions:** If you would like a Mass to be said for your intention, please send the details via email/phone/letter. Mass offering can be given on line, cheque or cash as above or put through the presbytery letter box.

**Guidelines for Mass:** 1. The stewards/volunteers will see that the church is thoroughly cleaned – door handles, pews and kneelers using antibacterial cleanser. 2. Each time you come to Mass sanitize your hands and occupy the marked seats on the benches. 3. Wear facemask. 4. One metre plus social distancing is to be kept inside the church and two metre outside. 5. No singing. 6. No bidding prayers. 7. Single use sheet/newsletter may be given and it is to be taken home or left at the exit for disposal. 8. Readers come to the microphone (not touch it) and read from their own single use sheet. 9. No Offertory procession, sharing of offertory plate/bag. 10. No physical sign of peace, but just a simple bow. 11. Holy Communion. After the prayer and its response “Behold the Lamb of God....Lord, I am not worthy”, the priest holds up the Sacred Host and says “The Body of Christ” to which people respond “Amen”; in the same way, he elevates the chalice and says “The Blood of Christ” to which they respond “Amen”. To receive Communion, they come forward and stand before the kneeler, kept as a physical barrier to socially distance the priest from the communicant, and stretch out their arms fully; then Communion is given silently in the hand and received silently as well. 12. After the Mass, while leaving the church also sanitize; no gathering outside the church.

**Mass attended by the public:** Only on **Friday, Saturday and Sunday**. Now as livestream is back, the other days people may attend Mass via livestream or spiritually.

**Gloria:** Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father. Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

**The Nicene Creed:** I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.
